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CHIAVARI (GE) LIGURIA - ITALY

PF-01 CAMOGLI & SAN FRUTTUOSO PUBLIC BOAT TOUR

You will be picked up by boat from the pier in Portofino to enjoy a cruise along the stunning Ligurian Coastline. You will discover the charm and magic of the inlets till you reach **San Fruttuoso**, an isolated fishing village which can be reached only by sea or on foot. San Fruttuoso dates back to the Roman age and is situated on the banks of an enchanting bay, set in the west side of the Promontory of Portofino beyond the lighthouse. Getting closer to the port, it appears with the majesty of its **13**th **century Abbey**, which dominates the beach with the irregular arches and its antique three-mullioned windows.

The guide will explain you, from the boat, the imposing Abbey dates back to the 8th century when the rests of the Saint, a martyred Spanish bishop, were transferred here. His ashes are still kept inside the Abbey. In 1265 this incredible monastic structure became property of the Doria family but, in 1983, the Doria Pamphilj donated it to the FAI (Fondo Italiano per l'Ambiente - Italian Environment Foundation) which restored it and opened it to the public.

Then you continue to **Camogli**, one of the most pleasant surprises on the Italian Riviera . Coming from the sea, the first thing that catches the eyes of the visitor is the colours of the houses: very tall houses painted of green, pink, ochre and yellow reflect on the clear waters of the old port... "The most brackish, hard and piratical place" Dickens used to write. After the local guide's introduction to the history of the town, you can stroll along the harbour and boardwalk via Garibaldi to discover the ice cream parlours, cafes and shops. You may even see some of the villagers knitting fishing nets!

PF - 01 BIS : CAMOGLI BY MINIVAN

Guests will be picked up by private minivan and transferred to **Camogli**,a typical fishing village and one of the prettiest pearls of the Ligurian Riviera.

Camogli is a little town , surrounded by mountains , which in the past boasted marvelous achievements rivaling those of the greatest nations on earth. From its origins on a small sandy beach, Camogli built one of the world's greatest merchant fleets and the town knew great prosperity. Recent archeological excavations have shown that people lived in the Camogli region as early as the 13th century B.C.

The original medieval setting at Camogli was centered around the local parish church on an island which was completely detached from the mainland. Today the island is connected to the mainland by a small square and some buildings. The island was surrounded by high walls which contained a small fortress, on these foundations the present bell tower of the parish church was built.

The walls of the island were built around 11C. and the castle became the seat of the local administration and remained so until the 18th century. Also a must is a visit to the parish church, dedicated to the Virgin Mary and named "Santa Maria Assunta". Today Camogli retains a vivid memory of its sailing tradition through the maritime Museum Giovanni Bono Ferari and the nautical institute Cristoforo Colombo, founded in 1874 and considered to be the most authoritative for the training of future naval officers.

After a guided visit of Camogli, guests will have free time to shop and walk around. Return to the minivan and drive back to Portofino passing the village of Ruta , on the pass of the same name , offers splendid views of the little town and of the coast

PF-02 RAPALLO & SANTA MARGHERITA PUBLIC BOAT TOUR

Passengers leave the ship to reach the coast by public ferry. After a 30 minute journey, during which the guide describes the scenery, they arrive at **Rapallo** where they visit the Castle outside, the historic centre with its painted facades, and the daily market.

Rapallo was founded during the Roman domain and several monuments relating back to the medieval times are still conserved . Rapallo is also known for having been the centre where important international treaties were signed. In Rapallo there are many boutiques and shops specialised in local handicrafts such as hand made lace and slate objects. Passengers will have some free time.

The tour continues sailing to **Santa Margherita**, another charming and colourful village on the Ligurian Riviera, where guests visit the church of Ns. Signora della Rosa in Baroque style .

Santa Margherita reached its splendour during the Middle Ages as the personal estate of the noble Genoese Fieschi family. At the end of XVII century it was named Porto Napoleone and enjoyed an indipendent administration .a witness of the past is borne today by the remains of the fifteenth century castle.

Free time for shopping will be leave to guests before reboarding the boat to back to Portofino.

PF-03 PORTOFINO WALK TOUR

Located on a promontory that just out into the Mediterranean, Portofino is blanketed in olive, pine, cypress and palm trees. This town is known for its unspoiled charm, romantic land and seascapes, and spectacular holiday homes.

The tour starts from the main square of Portofino, where the guide gives some general information to the guests.

Leaving the square the tour passes through the narrow streets surrounded by beautiful villas with gardens full of tropical plants and Mediterranean olive trees, cypress, pine and palm trees.

Portofino is known for its unspoiled charm, romantic land, seascapes, luxuriant villas, elegant shops and boutiques that surround the charming "piazzetta".

The tour goes up to the church of **St. George** where from it proceeds to Castle Brown gaze out over the Gulf of Rapallo and Portofino below. Continue along the pathway, which brings guests to the and "Faro" (lighthouse) at the far end of the Keep an eye out for elegant villas cloaked in luxuriant vegetation of tropical promontory. plants and olive trees.

From the "Faro" the tour returns to Portofino, where guests are free to walk around and do some shopping.

The meeting will be with the guide on the pier, from where you will go to reach the minivan . Experience the cuisine of the world-famous **Splendido Hotel** in this exclusive visit. This magnificent landmark overlooks the picturesque harbour of this tiny resort enclave. Favored by the wealthy and famous, the hotel is known for its superb Italian cuisine.

We have arranged for the maitre d' hotel to meet with you privately and explain the many uses and varieties of olive oil. You will have an opportunity to taste regional varieties of oil and learn how each is used in the preparation of delicious Italian dishes. Afterward, enjoy a delightful light lunch of Italian specialties prepared with olive oil and accompanied by wine.

OLIVE OIL

Men grew olives even before our earliest history was written. It is thought that this fruit first grew in the eastern Mediterranean basin. Hundreds of years ago it escaped from cultivation and began to grow wild all around the Mediterranean Sea. It was introduced in Italy during the Roman empire (VI century). Olive trees live longer than most other fruit trees. There are olives trees in Palestine which probably date back to the beginning of the Christian Era.

They have a remarkable power of growing where the climate is very hot and dry. But for bearing good fruit, it needs a moderate supply of water. The fruit matures from October to January, and is injured if the temperature falls below -3° C. (26° F.).

The Olive Oil is obtained by squeezing the olives and separating the oil from its own water. Depending on various grades of acidity you get extra virgin oil or normal olive oil. The extra virgin oil, after the first pressing, has a % of acidity that is less than 1 gr. which is very close to the composition of the fat in mother's milk and therefore very easy to assimilate and rich of vitamines A, D and E. The best oil comes from olives which are picked just after they ripen and before they turn black. If the olives are picked too green, the oil is bitter. If they are picked too ripe, the oil is rancid.

The olive oil is very important in the Italian cuisine and is mainly used to prepare: Pesto sauce, pasta and beans soup, minestrone, grilled or boiled fish, cooked or raw meat.

The best way to taste it is over a slice of baked bread or with a fresh green salad.

The various oils that you will taste during this meal, come from different parts of Italy, such as: Puglia (south of Italy), Tuscany (center) and Liguria (north). You will notice that Ligurian olive oil is lighter than the ones from the center or the south of Italy. This depends mainly on a different way and time of picking.

This was just a short note about olive oil, now it is time to taste and enjoy it. If you have any questions please do not hesitate to ask us.

PF - 05 LIGURIAN COOKING DEMONSTRATION

Italians are among the world's greatest cooks and this gastronomic introduction lets you into some of the secrets of Italian cuisine and, most importantly, allows you to sample them!

Ligurian cuisine is rich and tasty. Specialities of this area include focaccia, delicious bread made with olive oil, and pesto a heavenly sauce used to dress pasta and the locally caught fish.

The town of **Recco**, famous for its focaccia , it is full of trattorie specialising in local dishes and it is here that you will be welcomed to a gourmet restaurant by a chef who will let you into some of the secrets of his 'art'.

A demonstration will be given on how to make pesto sauce – ingredients of which include fresh basil, garlic, cheese and walnuts. You'll also see how to make 'trofie', the typical Ligurian hand made pasta and discover specialities such as pansotti .

Afterwards enjoy a leisurely lunch of wonderful Italian dishes - including some of your own creations. Locally produced wine will be served with lunch and your meal will be rounded off with dessert and coffee.

Passengers leave the ship to reach Portofino pier from where they'll jump into the ferry to be transferred to Santa Margherita Ligure to board the coach (15 minutes). Departure by A/C deluxe coach from Santa Margherita towards **Chiavari** (about 45 minutes) by motorway). Here guests will begin a walking tour of the historic centre of Chiavari , a charming and colourful village on the Riviera, which encloses the well-preserved buildings that still embody the typical features of an antique fortress. The churches and palaces were rebuilt last century, like the cathedral that is characterized by its gorgeus neoclassical façade with high columns.

Chiavari is a touristic and industrial center at the same time .It has nothing to envy the near towns.it is known all over the world owing to its chairs and special towels called "macramè." The tour then continues to the main Street " **carrugio**" where guests have some free time for shopping.

Guests then rejoin the coach and go to **Sestri Levante** , an ancient fishing village of Roman origin. It was founded by the Ligurian Tigulli with the name of Segeste and it grew in importance under the Roman Empire , even though it had to surrender to the barbaric invasions.

A thin strip of land joins the coast to a beautiful promontory which is called the isle , because up untill the last century it was not connected with the mainland. Poets such as Byron and Shelley stayed there, ans writers such as H.C:Andersen who left an admirable description of this journey in Italy. Don't forget that this town hosts important shipyards where motorships , fishing-baots , ferryboats are built. The tour ends driving back by coach to Santa Margherita , where rejoyn the boat to back to Portofino.

PF - 08 ABBAZIA DEI FIESCHI AND SESTRI LEVANTE

Departure by boat from Portofino towards Santa Margherita Ligure (15 minutes), where you jump into a deluxe coach and drive towards **S. Salvatore di Cogorno**. It is a natural oasis where man's hand has touched, surely, but without being able to master the environmental abundance of these places.

In about 45 minutes you reach the thirteenth century **Basilica dei Fieschi** where the papal cross of Innocenzo IV is kept. It is one of the most important medieval monuments of eastern Liguria. The history of the basilica of San Salvatore is linked with the struggle between the papacy and the government which witnessed as rivals, using fair means or foul Frederick II of Swabia and Innocenzo IV. Together with the Basilica , in 1252, was erected the lavish residence of the Fieschi family following the black and white band decoration of the church.

And finally you arrive in **Sestri Levante** . it is a very special place because it is divided by a narrow strip of land rich in vegetation and has two seas one on the "baia del silenzio" and one in the "Baia delle Favole", named by Andersen taken by its beauty. Sestri levante has remained faithful to its marine village origins, but has also been able to promote summer tourism with shopping and art.

After a short visit of the village, you will enjoy walking around its narrow carrugi . At the end of the morning, you rejoin the coach to back to S. Margherita, where you rejoyn the boat to back to Portofino .

PORTOFINO

PF 10A - 5 TERRE MANAROLA-RIOMAGGIORE-VERNAZZA-MONTEROSSO

In medieval times, the word "terra" (land) meant "village". **Cinque Terre** landscape is harsh and wild and even the coast reflects its nature. The Cinque Terre, recognized by UNESCO "World Heritage", are today a national Park and Protected Marine Area, protecting this great cultural heritage. Boarding the ferry to be transferred from Portofino to Santa Margherita Ligure, where you board the coach and will get to **Manarola**. Short time to visit the village and then by train reach **Riomaggiore** at the extreme eastern limit of the 5 terre, develops along the vineyards of the steep terraced valley down to the small harbour below.

Board the public ferry and sail towards **Vernazza.** It is a tiny resort located at the mouth of a river and is naturally protected from the threat of the sea by a rocky promontory: Vernazza has always been the only safe landing point in the Cinque Terre Vernazza has always had also a strong political and economical importance. Even nowadays, in fact, it appears as a noble and elegant village, located on a steep cliff.

Reboard the public boat and sail towards **Monterosso** whose medieval center has remained perfectly preserved with its tower-houses and "carrugi" (narrow alleys). The old part of Monterosso has remained practically unchanged and presents the same characteristics of the other villages the Cinque Terre. After a short guided tour you will have free time. In the afternoon you will board your coach to go back to Santa Margherita Ligure, from where you board the ferry to back to Portofino.

PF-12 GENOA PANORAMIC TOUR BY BUS

Departure by boat towards S-Margherita , where you get on an A/C deluxe coach and driving along the highway you arrive in Genoa. The guide points you the symbol of the towm : la lanterna (the lighthouse) which was built at the beginning of the 12^{th} century to show to the boats the entrance in the huge port of Genoa. To the east the old port includes a pleasure boat harbour , shipyards and embarkation terminals and quays for ferries leaving for the islands or Africa. To the west the modern port is fringed by an industrial zone with steel and chemical plants as well as oil refineries. This busy port handles imported raw materials and exports manufactured goods.

In 1162 Genoa became an indipendent town and consolidated its economic and political powerextending its domanin and becoming a wealthy and magnificent city. The headquarters was **the bank of st George** which stands in the sailors'quarter; behind the palace is the Loggia dei mercanti which is now a fruit and vegetable market. The tour then continues through **Corso italia** and you will reach a corner where other pictures of the typical seamen's life are featured is **Boccadasse**, a small harbour, encircled by multicoloured fishermen's houses.

The tour then continues to **Corso Buenos Aires** and Via XX Settembre, in the commercial area of the Town, where we can stop and spend some time for shopping in the main street of Genova.

Back on the bus we start the visit of **Piazza Dante** to see "Columbus' House" (outside) and "Porta Soprana" the main city gate of the XIIth century's city walls. Carrying on to Via Fieschi and **Carignano** with the Basilica of Santa Maria Assunta, passing the beautiful Piazza Corvetto, the tour continues as far as the hill of "Castelletto" where passengers can admire the view of the historical centre.

Returning to the town the coach will pass through *Piazza Nunziata*, *Via Balbi, Piazza Acquaverde* (with its monument dedicated to C. Columbus) and the wonderful "Villa Andrea Doria", built in the XVIth century for the famous admiral and still surrounded by a big park full of sculptures and fountains.

Drive back along the highway towards S.Margherita Ligure, where you rejoyn the boat and back to Portofino.

A public ferry embarks passengers at the pier in Portofino and transfers them to Santa Margherita Ligure , where they board A/C coaches to reach ${\bf Genoa}$ by motorway.

Genoa is one of the ancient Italian Sea Republics, and one of the main ports on the Mediterran sea. Passengers will visit the heart of the old historical centre of Genoa, through Piazza Banchi along the old narrow streets to the beautiful gothic roman church of San Matteo.

Walking along the narrow streets of the old city centre you will reach the ${\bf Cathedral}$. It has been built between the 12C and 16C , has a splendid Gothic façade , typical of the Genoese style. French influence appears in the placing of the 13C doorways and the large rose window.

Walking along they will arrive at **Piazza de Ferrari**, which is bordered by the theatre Carlo Felice which was restored a few years ago. There is the Ducal palace with its monumental façade overlooking on the square. Here passengers will be able to admire the city centre square with the fountain in the centre surrounded by old buildings.

The tour then continues to the expò area , where the guides will give you the tickets to go **inside the aquarium** , which is the largest in italy and the second one in Europe after which one in Valencia (Spain) . It was open in 1992 in occasion of the Columbus' celabrations. The three most important tanks are the ones which house dolphins, sharkes and seals.

The aquarium was enlarged using the hull of a ship called NAVE ITALIA and house a big number of open tanks . In some of them the guest can introduce his hands and touch directly the fishes.

Free time will be given to clients for shopping and browsing around. The tour ends back in Santa Margherita Liqure, from where quests sail to Portofino by private ferry.

Here stands the building of the first Italian bank "Banco di San Giorgio" with its painted façade.

The Aquarium is the largest in Europe and is an eloquent tribute to Genoa's link with the sea and surrounding coastal waters.

Designed by the Genoese architect Renzo Piano and by Peter Chermayeff, it is located on a quay jutting out into the waters of the Porto Antico area. From the outside it resembles a series of freight containers placed atop a cargo ship, the beauty of the building fits in perfectly with the characteristics of the port area.

Opened in 1992, completed in 1993, it was enlarged in 1998 with the addition of a 100 meters long ship moored at the far end and connected to the main building by a walkway. Inside the huge tanks form virtual walls of water among which guests can wander accompanied by the sound of waves, currents and echoes from the deep.

Some tanks of the Aquarium reproduce natural environments from different areas as the Antarctic, the Mediterranean, the Red Sea, the Amazon and the Indian Ocean. The most spectacular ones are those housing the sharks, the dolphins and the seals, which are the most fun to watch. Seals, sharks and penguins, spiders and crocodiles make the fun of children and grown-ups. Very impressive is the reproduction of a coral reef from the Caribbean with an incredible variety of coral, plants, peculiar sea creatures and brightly coloured fish.

Guests will be provided by a ticket to go in and then they have three hours at disposal for visiting it. At the end of the visit, meet with the guide, board the coach and drive back to Savona.

In later times the same homes hosted the distinguished visitors which included the Liguria capital in their Grand Tour cultural and / or tourist itinerary. The Rolli represent a set or *unicum* of the most prestigious palaces of Genoa.

The first museum will be **Palazzo Rosso** which is the art collections of the Brignole-Sale. Works by van Dyck, Durer, Guercino, Veronese, Reni and Strozzi. The new rooms are enriched with valuable furniture and paintings. it is possible to reach the belvedere on top of the old city centre with the panoramic lift.

The second museum will be **Palazzo Bianco** which is a painting museum referred to the Italian pictures from the end of '400 to the beginning of '700; the last museum will be **Palazzo Tursi**, which is the house of the major of town, but it also houses the famous violin belonged to the musician Paganini.

For 700 years, the history of Monaco has been linked to that of the Grimaldi Dynasty which has celebrated in 1997 the anniversary of its accession to the Principality of Monaco.

Benefiting from an ideal geographical location, the principality of Monaco enjoys very mild winters and remarkably sunny summers which tend not to be exceedingly hot. Thanks to its Mediterranean climate, Monaco is a pleasant place to live all year round.

With the guide you will visit the Cathedral, where is buried the former Prince and his wife: the American actress Grace Kelly. An outside visit of the Royal Palace, where every morning at midday there is the changing of guard.

Genoa has been for centuries a passageway from the Mediterranean to the Northern plains, from Northern to Southern Old World, from old World to the new one. In the 6th century B.C. Phoenician or Etruscan merchants established themselves on the hill over the bay. In the Middle ages this bay became the heart of a great Maritime Republic, whose colonies spread from West to the far East. Today Genoa is the first Mediterranean port and the European cruise terminal.

Then you will proceed walking up to the main entrance of **Ducal Palace**, to **the church of Saint Ambrogio** (a richly frescoed church, where two paintings by Rubens are to be found), **Soprana Gate and Columbus house** and finally gets to Piazza de Ferrari, where the famous opera house Carlo Felice stands.

At the end of the guided tour, free time is given to guests for shopping and typical lunch in the most important commercial area: Via XX Settembre and via Roma.

PV 01 -LEANING TOWER OF PISA HD

Pisa, only 40 miles driving from Portovenere, was once famous as a seatrading republic, the main rival of nearby Genoa. Today it is a tourist city with the Leaning Tower on a lovely green lawn and the adjacent Cathedral and Baptistery. Scattered across a golf-course-green lawn are four large white buildings that make up Pisa's religious center: the Cathedral, its bell tower (the Leaning Tower), Baptistery and Camposanto Cemetery. The four buildings share similar building materials, comparable decoration, and a tendency toward circular designs, giving the Campo a pleasant visual unity.

The construction of the **Cathedral** started in 1063 to commemorate the Pisans defeat of the Saracens in Sicily that year. Its interior pillars were brought back from the Moslem lands during the campaigns. In the half-dome there are superb 13th century mosaics by Cimabue.

The **Leaning Tower** was designed as a bell tower to the Cathedral and construction started in 1174. It was finally finished in 1350.

Its leaning (4m-13 feet at the top) is caused by the settling of the alluvium subsoil , which lacks the resistance to withstand the weight of the tower. The tower is cylindrical and comprises six open galleries , which give an illusion of spiralling upwards due to the inclination. Lower down , the blind arcades are adorned with lozenges in the true Pisan style. The 294 steps lead to the top terrace from which there is a striking view.

After the guided visit, some free time will give to you to walk around, before reboarding the coach and back to Portovenere.

PV 02 - PORTOVENERE WALKING TOUR

Portovenere is an ancient 12th century town where tall and coloured houses still remain and the port. The first knowing dwelling on uncertain date, was built on the extreme point of the little peninsular of Portovenere. Thanks to its spectacular position on the narrow rock promontory on the sea, it also represents one of the most unique towns of the Ligurian coast.

Today Portovenere is included in UNESCO'world heritage for the tutelage of a cultural landscape . Start your walking tour by passing under the **ancient arch** to enter Caruggio, and walk to the end where on the rocky promontory at the edge of town, amongst ancient forts, stands the **Church of St. Peter** (13^{th} century) , with its black and white stripes , connected to an older Paleochristian structure. Built by the Genoese between 1256 and 1277 on the remains of a paleo –Christian church, superimposed on a pagan temple dedicated to the goddess Venus Ericina, it was involved in the historical vicissitudes of Portovenere.

From the square in front you can enjoy a magnificent view on Andrea Doria castle and its imposing structure; it represents an excellent model of Genoese military architecture. It is made up to a low building with a main entrance door and a high building incorporating the 16^{th} century structure with the big Hypostyle Hall on which there is the captain's House.

Continue the walk to portside for panoramic view of the town and the three islands , Palmaria Tino and Tinetto are in the Portovenere regional Nature park , set up on September 2001 to safeguard the environment. Around the islands there are inlets and natural caves , including the charming Grotta Azzurra (Blue grotto) which you can get to by boat.

Pause to enjoy a tasting of the delicious local wine before returning to the ship.

Departure from the pier by A/C Deluxe coach, and driving along the highway after about 1,5 hours guests will arrive at Lucca. **Lucca** was colonised by Romans in the 2c BC and it has retained the plan of a Roman military camp, with the two principal streets perpendicular to one another. During the Middle ages a complicated system of narrow alleys and oddly-shaped squares was added to the original network.

From 1550 onwards the town became an important agricultural centre and with this new prosperity came a renewed interest in building. The countryside was dotted with villas , the town encircled by ramparts. When Napoleon arrived he liked so much that he gave it to his sister as a gift. It was later passed on to napoleon's widow marie Louise, who with her feminine sensitivity fortified wall into a fine city park that is much enjoyed today.

You will visit the beautiful **Cathedral of San Martino**, which houses the Volto Santo (Holy visage) who is a miraculous Crucifix . Then continue to **Piazza Anfiteatro** (the Roman Amphitheater) which today is a circle of touristy shops and the street's level is nine feet above the original arena floor .the only bits of surviving Roman stonework are a few arches on the northwest exterior. And you are in **via Filungo** , the main pedestrian street. Along the way you will get a taste of Lucca's rich past, including several elegant , century –old storefronts.

From here you walk towards **Torre Guinigi** crowned with trees which rises above the great façade with gothic windows; some of the bays are blind. Then you see the outside of the Church of San Michele and San Frediano.

After the guided visit the guests will have one-hour approximately free time. Guests will meet again in Piazzale Verdi to leave Lucca and return to Portovenere.

Manarola has a church in Gothic-Ligurian style of 1338 and, at Volastra is the shrine of the "madonna della salute" (health), one of the most picturesque on the coast, which has worshipped since the 10th century.

Board the boat and sail towards **Vernazza** which is a tiny resort located at the mouth of a river and is naturally protected from the threat of the sea by a rocky promontory: Vernazza has always been the only safe landing point in the Cinque Terre Vernazza has always had also a strong political and economical importance which is witnessed by the style of its houses and streets, decorated with loggias and refined arcades. Even nowadays, in fact, it appears as a noble and elegant village, located on a steep cliff.

Here, in summer, sunbathers mix with fishermen. The Cinque Terre, recognized by UNESCO "World Heritage", are today a national Park and Protected Marine Area, protecting this great cultural heritage.

Boarding the boat you will get to **Monterosso** whose medieval center has remained perfectly preserved with its tower-houses and "carrugi" (narrow alleys). The old part of Monterosso has remained practically unchanged and presents the same characteristics of the other villages of the Cinque Terre. As Monterosso was subject to continuous sea battles, defense structures were built: the Castle, overlooking the sea, the Aurora Tower which is the only one standing out of the thirteen towers that in the XVII century used to surround the village.

After the guided tour of Monterosso and some free time spent at your leisure, you will board the boat to **Vernazza**. Vernazza is a tiny resort located at the mouth of a river and is naturally protected from the threat of the sea by a rocky promontory: Vernazza has always been the only safe landing point in the Cinque Terre Vernazza has always had also a strong political and economical importance which is witnessed by the style of its houses and streets, decorated with loggias and refined arcades. PV 09 - A TASTE OF FLORENCE FD

Departure from Portovenere by A/C deluxe coach, the journey takes approximately 2,5 hours through the Tuscany countryside. , which is bathed by a diaphanous , amber light . The low surrounding hills are clad with olive groves, vineyards and cypresses which appear to have been landscaped to please the human eye. Meeting with the local guide and start the walking tour to **Piazza del Duomo** , where stands the huge cathedral dedicated to Santa Maria del Fiore which was built over the ruins of the old church of S.Reparata . This Gothic cathedral is an outstanding example of the Florentine variant of this style , with its sheer size, predominance of horizontal lines and taste for polychrome decoration. To counteract the excessive thrust , Brunelleschi built two concentric domes which were linked by props. It is possible to go up to the inner gallery which offers an impressive view of the nave, and then on up to the top of the dome (464 steps) with its magnificent panorama of Florence.

Next to the dome there is the **Giotto's bell Tower** and is the perfect complement to Brunelleschi's dome. Its geometric decoration with its emphasis on horizontal lines is unusual. From the top there is a fine panorama of the cathedral and town. Walk towards **Piazza della Signoria**, the political stage of Florence, with a wonderful backcloth formed by the Palazzo Vecchio, the Loggia della Signoria and in the wings the uffizi museum. The many statues make it virtually an open —air museum of sculpture.

Round the corner and a view on **Ponte vecchio**, this Florence's oldest bridge, which crosses the Arno at its narrowest point, and has been rebuilt several times .it has a curious appearance with jewellers'shops lining the roadway and above the Corridoio Vasariano. The last visit will be inside the Franciscans church of **Santa Croce**, which was designed for preaching and consists of a single spacious nave and slender apse with fine 15c stained glass window. The church is paved with 276 tombstones and along the walls are sumptuous tombs. The first chapel to the right of the altar contains moving frescoes by Giotto depicting the life of St. Francis.

This Gothic cathedral is an outstanding example of the Florentine variant of this style , with its sheer size, predominance of horizontal lines and taste for polychrome decoration. To counteract the excessive thrust , Brunelleschi built two concentric domes which were linked by props. It is possible to go up to the inner gallery which offers an impressive view of the nave, and then on up to the top of the dome (464 steps) with its magnificent panorama of Florence.

Next to the dome there is the **Giotto's bell Tower** and is the perfect complement to Brunelleschi's dome . Its geometric decoration with its emphasis on horizontal lines is unusual. From the top there is a fine panorama of the cathedral and town. Walk towards **Piazza della Signoria** , the political stage of Florence , with a wonderful backcloth formed by the Palazzo Vecchio , the Loggia della Signoria and in the wings the uffizi museum. The many statues make it virtually an open —air museum of sculpture.

Round the corner and a view on **Ponte vecchio**, this Florence's oldest bridge, which crosses the Arno at its narrowest point, and has been rebuilt several times .it has a curious appearance with jewellers'shops lining the roadway and above the Corridoio Vasariano. The last visit will be inside the Franciscans church of **Santa Croce**, which was designed for preaching and consists of a single spacious nave and slender apse with fine 15c stained glass window. The church is paved with 276 tombstones and along the walls are sumptuous tombs. The first chapel to the right of the altar contains moving frescoes by Giotto depicting the life of St. Francis.

After a typical lunch offered in a local Florentine restaurant guests we'll have free time for shopping and browsing in town, before reboard the coach and back to Portovenere

PV 14 - LUCCA & PISA TOUR

Departure from the pier by A/C Deluxe coach, and driving along the highway after about 1,5 hours guests will arrive at Lucca. Lucca was colonised by Romans in the 2c BC and it has retained the plan of a Roman military camp, with the two principal streets perpendicular to one another. During the Middle ages a complicated system of narrow alleys and oddly-shaped squares was added to the original network.

You will visit the beautiful **Cathedral of San Martino**, which houses the Volto Santo (Holy visage) who is a miraculous Crucifix . Then continue to **Piazza Anfiteatro** (the Roman Amphitheater) which today is a circle of touristy shops and the street's level is nine feet above the original arena floor .the only bits of surviving Roman stonework are a few arches on the northwest exterior. And you are in **via Filungo** , the main pedestrian street. Along the way you will get a taste of Lucca's rich past, including several elegant , century —old storefronts.

From here you walk towards **Torre Guinigi** crowned with trees which rises above the great façade with gothic windows; some of the bays are blind. Then you see the outside of the Church of San Michele and San Frediano.

After some free time guests will return to the coach for a short ride, only about 30 min. drive to arrive at **Pisa**. Here they will visit on their own Piazza dei Miracoli, the magnificent "Miracles'square ", where they will be able to enjoy the view of the Cathedral, the Baptistry an the Leaning Tower .

The **Leaning Tower** was designed as a bell tower to the Cathedral and construction started in 1174. It was finally finished in 1350. Its leaning (4m-13 feet at the top) is caused by the settling of the alluvium subsoil , which lacks the resistance to withstand the weight of the tower. The tower is cylindrical and comprises six open galleries , which give an illusion of spiralling upwards due to the inclination. Lower down , the blind arcades are adorned with lozenges in the true Pisan style. The 294 steps lead to the top terrace from which there is a striking view.

PV 15 - VISIT TO THE MARBLE CAVES HD

Guests will be picked up from the pier in Portovenere, and board an A/C deluxe coach towards **Carrara**. During the driving, the guide will explain the evolution of the territory which has been always linked to the excavation of marble since Roman times.

The excavation decreased during the High Middle Age and increased again after the year one thousand. In the first half of the 16th century Michelangelo came frequently in Carrara to choose the stone for his masterpieces. Over the centuries the marble of Carrara has been recognized as a precious stone for buildings and for its white and colour varieties.

In the Apuan Alps the spectacular **marble quarries** offer an evocative sight. Here this precious stone was used for different purposes: from the simple objects to more famous works of art and architecture. Chian of mountains crests which stand out clear and impressive on the remaining Appennino, this landscape with its still here and there intact places, and its marble quarries on the slopes is two thousand years old at least.

Before going back to the ship, a stop at a laboratory for a tasting of "lardo". It is derived from cuts of italian pork, which are never inferior to 3 centimetres , it hides in the preparation and in the seasoning , the secrets of its excellence. The classic and unique container for the curation of the lardo is the "conca di marmo" a type of tub made of marble from the canaloni quarries of Colonnata. SP 02 - THE LEANING TOUR OF PISA HD

Pisa, only 40 miles driving from La Spezia , was once famous as a seatrading republic, the main rival of nearby Genoa. Today it is a tourist city with the Leaning Tower on a lovely green lawn and the adjacent Cathedral and Baptistery. Scattered across a golf-course-green lawn are four large white buildings that make up Pisa's religious center : the Cathedral , its bell tower (the Lenaing Tower) , Baptistery and Camposanto Cemetery. The four buildings share similar building materials , comparable decoration, and a tendency toward circular designs , giving the Campo a pleasant visual unity.

The construction of the **Cathedral** started in 1063 to commemorate the Pisans defeat of the Saracens in Sicily that year. Its interior pillars were brought back from the Moslem lands during the campaigns. In the half-dome there are superb 13th century mosaics by Cimabue.

The **Leaning Tower** was designed as a bell tower to the Cathedral and construction started in 1174. It was finally finished in 1350.

Its leaning (4m - 13 feet at the top) is caused by the settling of the alluvium subsoil , which lacks the resistance to withstand the weight of the tower. The tower is cylindrical and comprises six open galleries , which give an illusion of spiralling upwards due to the inclination. Lower down , the blind arcades are adorned with lozenges in the true Pisan style. The 294 steps lead to the top terrace from which there is a striking view.

SP 05 – 5 TERRE TOUR

Explore three of the charming villages that make up the Cinque Terre. Perched on a rocky coast north of Portovenere, these villages were once isolated and accessible only by sea. Each unique, they retain the charm of another era and are surrounded by some of the most breathtaking scenery along the Italian coast.

Board your bus at the port and drive through the lush countryside to the village of **Manarola**. Manarola is a small center with old characteristic houses on the sea rocks. Manarola has a church in Gothic-Ligurian style of 1338 and, at Volastra is the shrine of the "Madonna della Salute" (health), one of the most picturesque on the coast, which has been the site of worship since the 10th century.

After the visit board on the train and reach the town of Riomaggiore.

Riomaggiore is the most eastern of the Cinque Terre. The name derives from "Rivus Major" which flows through it. There you will find the sanctuary of the "Madonna of Montenero" and a 14th century castle.

A short distance away (BY BOAT) is **Vernazza** with its charming harbor filled with fishing boats and surrounded by sidewalk cafes. Every direction offers a photographic opportunity. A tiny church perched on the cliff beckons.

Small shops offer treasured mementos. Vernazza was a community founded towards the year 1000 around the chapel. By the 12th century this community had extended it territory down to the harbor. At that time the Lords of the Vara valley built an armed and fortified base and, together with Genoa, they countered the ruthless Saracen oppression with their fast ships. All that remains of this old base is the Rock and some ruins of the towers. The town overrides a partly hidden river and opens out on a little square by the beach. It is dominated by a beautiful church in Gothic-Ligurian style of 1318, dedicated to "Saint Margaret of Antioch".

Come back to Manarola by train and walk from the parking area up a road closed to traffic, get on coach and return to La Spezia.

SP 06 - 5 TERRE BY PUBLIC BOAT HD

In medieval times, the word "terra" (land) meant "village". This is the origin of the name of this beautiful area: Cinque Terre (Five Villages). The inhabitants of these places had agricultural origins and lived on the hills. They came down to the coast once the Saracens had finished invading, when the sea became safe; they populated the villages at the mouths of the rivers along the shore. **Cinque Terre** landscape is harsh and wild and even the coast reflects its nature. High cliffs dropping down into the cobalt blue depths of the sea, hiding minute shingle beaches at Riomaggiore and Vernazza, or tiny ports like at Manarola. Here, in summer, sunbathers mix with fishermen. The Cinque Terre, recognized by UNESCO "World Heritage", are today a national Park and Protected Marine Area, protecting this great cultural heritage.

Boarding the boat you will get to **Vernazza**. Vernazza is a tiny resort located at the mouth of a river and is naturally protected from the threat of the sea by a rocky promontory: Vernazza has always been the only safe landing point in the Cinque Terre Vernazza has always had also a strong political and economical importance which is witnessed by the style of its houses and streets, decorated with loggias and refined arcades. Even nowadays, in fact, it appears as a noble and elegant village, located on a steep cliff.

After the guided tour of Vernazza and some free time spent at your leisure, you will board the boat to **Monterosso** whose medieval center has remained perfectly preserved with its tower-houses and "carrugi" (narrow alleys). The old part of Monterosso has remained practically unchanged and presents the same characteristics of the other villages of the Cinque Terre. As Monterosso was subject to continuous sea battles, defense structures were built: the Castle, overlooking the sea, the Aurora Tower which is the only one standing out of the thirteen towers that in the XVII century used to surround the village.

Today Portofino is one of the most famous resorts of the world , internationally celabrated for its luxury tourism . A quiet fishing village with tall and colourful houses facing in a semi-circle the square and the harbour. Portofino is today undoubtedly a place for the rich, in which however is possible for anymone to enter into the atmosphere of an incomparable corner of Liguria and acknoledge the signs of a simple and century —old diligence of the men at sea and their women on land, the latter occupied in making fine lace from Flemish thread.

Guest will have free time to stroll around , reach along a small path plunged in the luxuriant green panorama the lighthouse ; visit the panoramic church of Saint George where are preserved the Saint's relics which were brought in Portofino by the sailors who had come back from the crusade ; shopping in the famous boutique of italian artists.

After free time guests rejoin the public boat and sail back to Santa Margherita, where the bus is waiting for driving back to La Spezia .

GE- 02 GENOA PANORAMIC TOUR BY BUS

Departure by A/C deluxe coach from the harbour and first the guide points you the symbol of the towm: **la lanterna** (the lighthouse) which was built at the beginning of the 12th century to show to the boats the entrance in the huge port of Genoa. To the east the **old port** includes a pleasure boat harbour, shipyards and embarkation terminals and quays for ferries leaving for the islands or Africa. To the west the modern port is fringed by an industrial zone with steel and chemical plants as well as oil refineries. This busy port handles imported raw materials and exports manufactured goods.

In 1162 Genoa became an indipendent town and consolidated its economic and political powerextending its domanin and becoming a wealthy and magnificent city. The headquarters was **the bank of st George** which stands in the sailors'quarter; behind the palace is the Loggia dei mercanti which is now a fruit and vegetable market. The tour then continues through Corso italia and you will reach a corner where other pictures of the typical seamen's life are featured is **Boccadasse**, a small harbour, encircled by multicoloured fishermen's houses. The tour then continues to Corso Buenos Aires and Via XX Settembre, in the commercial area of the Town, where we can stop and spend some time for shopping in the main street of Genova.

Back on the bus we start the visit of Piazza Dante to see "Columbus' House" (outside) and "Porta Soprana" the main city gate of the XIIth century's city walls. Carrying on to Via Fieschi and Carignano with the Basilica of Santa Maria Assunta, passing the beautiful Piazza Corvetto, the tour continues as far as the hill of "Castelletto" where passengers can admire the view of the historical centre.

Returning to the town the coach will pass through **Piazza Nunziata, Via Balbi, Piazza Acquaverde** (with its monument dedicated to C. Columbus) and the wonderful "Villa Andrea Doria", built in the XVIth century for the famous admiral and still surrounded by a big park full of sculptures and fountains. Tour will end at the pier.

GE-03 GENOA AND THE AQUARIUM

Departure by A/C deluxe coach from the harbour and reach the Expò area where there is the famous **Aquarium.** The largest Aquarium in Europe is an eloquent tribute to Genoa's link with the sea and surrounding coastal waters.

Designed by the Genoese architect Renzo Piano and by Peter Chermayeff, it is located on a quay jutting out into the waters of the Porto Antico area. Friom the outside it resembles a series of freight containers placed atop a cargo ship, the beauty of the building fits in perfectly with the characteristics of the port area.

Opened in 1992, completed in 1993, it was enlarged in 1998 with the addition of a 100 meters long ship moored at the far end and connected to the main building by a walkway. Inside the huge tanks form virtual walls of water among which guests can wander accompained by the sound of waves, currents and echoes from the deep.

Some tanks of the Aquarium reproduce natural environments from different areas as the Antarctic, the Mediterranean, the Red Sea, the Amazon and the Indian Ocean. The most spectacular ones are those housing the sharks, the dolphins and the seals, which are the most fun to watch. Seals, sharks and penguins, spiders and crocodiles make the fun of children and grown-ups. Very impressive is the reproduction of a coral reef from the Caribbean with an incredible variety of coral, plants, peculiar sea creatures and brightly coloured fish.

After the visit at the Aquarium, **a guided tour of the town** last approximately 2 hours and give a good view of its old area. You will see palazzo S.Giorgio which was the headquarters of the famous bank of St.George .Then walking through the alleys you reach **the cathedral of S. Lorenzo** which has got a splendid Gothic façade typical of the Genoese style . Then continue walking to piazza de Ferrari where the Ducal Palace stands. Then back to the ship by foot.

Departure by coach from the harbour driving along the Riviera coast to **Camogli**, a typical fishing village which is one of the prettiest pearls of the Ligurian Riviera.

Camogli is situated on the west of the Promontory of Portofino , and boasts an ancient tradition in navigation of sailing vessels, which reached its peak in the second half of the 19th century. In 1852 the first maritime mutual insurance company was founded , which permitted the insured who had lost a sailing ship to obtain a new one. Today Camogli retains a vivid memory of its sailing tradition through the maritime museum and the Nautical Institute Cristoforo Colombo.

The town centre is a small isle linked to the land, and it spreads all around the port with its **Parish Church and the Dragonara castle**. The small port built at the bottom of the houses rising from the rocks, and the rows of high houses represent the distinctive scenery of Camogli.

Here guests will spend 1 hour on a walking guided tour followed by some free time to stroll around and shop. They will visit the church of S.Maria Assunta, originally of the 11^{th} century but later transformed , which houses many works of Ligurian artists. The medieval zone perched on the rocks of the harbour is the age —old -residence of fishermen's families . Also the traditions and tourist manifestations of Camogli are solidly linked to the sea and its world. In the characteristic port, on the second Sunday in may , the famous sagra del pesce (fishing festival) takes place: enormous quantities of fish fried in a huhe pan are ofeered to everyone present

The small port built at the bottom of the houses rising from the rocks, and the rows of high houses represent the distinctive scenery of Camogli.

Here guests will spend 30 minutes on a walking guided tour followed by some free time to stroll around and shop. They will visit the **church of S.Maria Assunta**, originally of the $11^{\rm th}$ century but later transformed , which houses many works of Ligurian artists. The medieval zone perched on the rocks of the harbour is the age –old -residence of fishermen's families .

Guests then board a public boat and sail towards the bay of S.Fruttuoso overlooked by the church and the abbey. From the boat the guide will explain the history of the village: the deep fascination of S.Fruttuoso lies in the architectural value of the abbey and the church as well as in the splendid natural surroundings in which these historical buildings are set. The original monastery was built in 711 and in the 13^{th} century , protected by the powerful Doria family reached its maximum development.

After a short stop, the clients will take another public boat back to sail towards to Portofino.

A thin strip of land joins the coast to a beautiful promontory which is called the isle , because up untill the last century it was not connected with the mainland. Poets such as Byron and Shelley stayed there, and writers such as H.C:Andersen who left an admirable description of this journey in Italy. Don't forget that this town hosts important shipyards where motorships , fishing-baots , ferryboats are built.

GE-17 A VISIT TO THE CITY OF MILAN

The journey takes about 2 hours along the motorway . Milan is the second city in Italy as regards population, politics and cultural affairs , and first in the field of commerce , industry and banking.. After some barbarian darkness , medieval Milan rose to regional prominence under the Visconti and Sforza families.. By the time of the renaissance , it was nicknamed " the new Athens " and was enough of a cultural center for leonardo to call home.

The visit of Milan starts with city's centerpiecewhich is the largest church in Europe , after the Vatican's, London's and Sevilla's. for good measure , the cathedral was built not of ordinary stone but of marble . this marvel of white marble , both colossal and ethereal , bristling with belfries, gables , pinnacles and statues , stands at one end of a great paved esplanade .The overall design is the work of a french architect . In contrast with the exterior there is the interior which is bare , severe and imposing. The windows of the nave , aisles and transept have some lovely stained glass , some of which dates back to the 15 and 16 century.

Then a short walk through Galleria Vittorio Emanuele which is a symbol of Milan and it was the first building in town to have electrical lighting. Here you can turn a cup of coffee into a good value by enjoying Europe's best people-watching. The tour continues to visti from outside the famous opera —house La Scala opened in 1778 with an opera by Antonio Salieri . the acoustics are perfect and can accomodate an audience of over 2000 persons.

At the end of the guided tour, free time for shopping in the famous Italian designers'street Via Spiga and via Montenapoleone.
